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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST (for Ontario Residents Only)

"Métis means a person who self-identifies as Métis, is distinct from other Aboriginal peoples, is of historic Métis ancestry, and is accepted by the Métis Nation."

The historic Métis Nation arose in the 1700s from the union of European men First Nations women. By this time there were recognizable Métis communities across the Métis Nation Homeland and the Métis People had developed a culture, history, and lifestyle which were distinct from First Nations or Inuit peoples.

Thank you for applying for citizenship with the Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO). Please note that due to the large volume of mail and applications the registry receives, fully documented applications will be processed immediately upon reception while applications that are missing documents will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis as time permits. To avoid delays please ensure that you are providing ALL required documents to the Registry Branch.
